Transactional Analysis is a psychological theory of personality. It offers ways of understanding our own personality and the relationships we have with others. It is also a form of psychotherapy. You may want to participate if you:

- are somebody who would like to become qualified as a Psychotherapist or Counsellor.
- would like to enhance your understanding / skills in working with people.
- are practising as a Counsellor and want to develop your effectiveness.
- would like to personally develop yourself with like-minded people.

Participation in the programme is flexible; training takes place at weekends (apart from one Friday for Group B), training years do not have to be consecutive, hours towards accreditation can be achieved at the student's own pace and missed training days can potentially be made up with the parallel group.

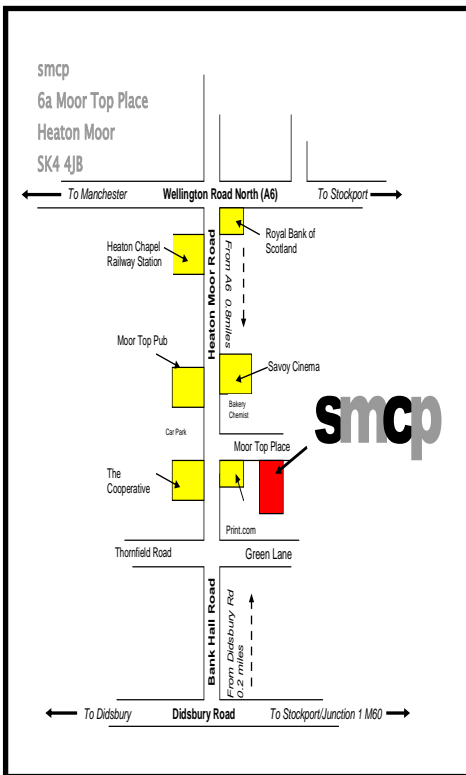

Directions from Manchester

Follow signs for Stockport A6.

As you leave Levenshulme pass the McVities factory on your right.

Turn Right into Heaton Moor Road in 0.7 miles.

Moor Top place (unadopted road) is 0.8 miles on your left, opposite the Cooperative Supermarket and just before the Pelican Crossing.

Directions from M60

Leave M60 at Junction 1.

Take roundabout exit signposted Didsbury.

In 0.6 miles turn right at lights into Bank Hall Road.

This becomes Moor Side Road, then Heaton Moor Road.

Moor Top Place is 0.2 miles on your right opposite the Cooperative Supermarket and just after the Pelican Crossing.

Directions from Didsbury

From Town Centre follow Wilmslow Road – signposted Stockport.

At Tesco bear left and cross Kingsway (large dual carriage way) on to Didsbury Road.

In 1 mile turn left at third set of lights into Bank Hall Road.

This becomes Moor Side Road, then Heaton Moor Road.

Moor Top Place is 0.2 miles on your right opposite the Cooperative Supermarket and just after the Pelican Crossing.
